About Syed

- A visionary leader who pioneered the Sindhi freedom movement, remains a beacon of the Sindhi people's struggle for national self-determination.
- He was repeatedly detained and imprisoned by Pakistani authorities, spending more than thirty years without trial or ever being charged. He died in custody in 1995.
- The Amnesty International adopted him as a Prisoner of Conscience.
- He wrote extensively on Sindhi identity, history, and political conditions in Sindh. His views continue to inspire Sindhi writers, poets, political and civic leaders, and social and religious activists.
- He is widely respected for his forthrightness, courage, simplicity, and insightfulness.






